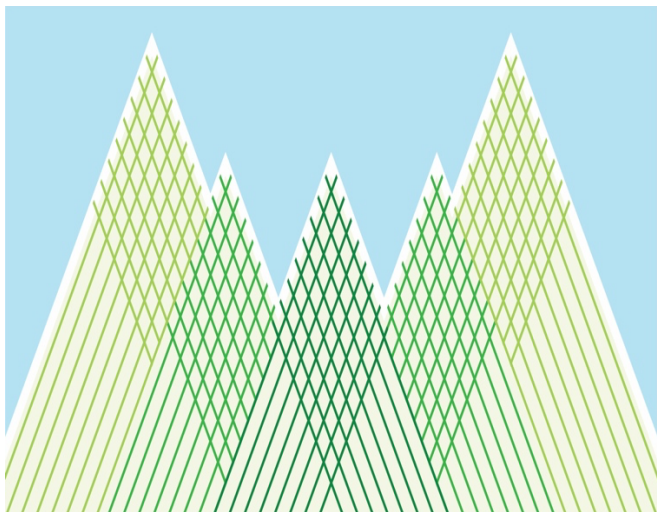
### PINOT NOIR + PINE TIPS

#### QUICK SUMMARY:

The etymology of Pinot Noir is the pine cone. So, for me, the match had already been established. It just took some bold creativity to imagine them together somehow. As a tough critic of my own wines and Willamette Valley Pinot Noir in general, I was not happy with how my 2019 Pinot Noir was tasting that Spring of 2020. Time to get creative. Time to think outside the box. Those memories of pine tips came to mind and a new wine was born.

.Once the desired taste was achieved, the wine was again put to bed. In total, the wine spent 28 months in barrels, gaining compaction, depth, and a singular expression of Pinot Noir from our pine covered hill behind Forest Grove.
