QUICK SUMMARY:



Grown in the hills above Forest Grove, our 'NOBURG' Pinot Noir is exclusively made with the rare clone 943. It is known that clone 943 is one of the preferred clones that Professor Raymond Bernard has cultivated. The clone has only been available to growers in the USA since 2004. This is not your typical Pinot Noir. These tiny-berried clusters offer extremely dark colors and a flavor profile that is more blackberry, iron, and pomegranate. This wine was made in our "noble reduction" method, resulting in a complex tasting experience. These grapes are grown in deep loess soils and dry farmed. The wine was fermented using native yeast, and was bottled unfiltered (Vegan) and unfiltered.
