
ON WINE HILL 'MILLERANDAGE' PINOT NOIR (CLONE 943)

Redacted Vineyard, Tualatin Hills AVA Willamette Valley, Oregon, U.S.A

QUICK SUMMARY:

Grown in the hills above Forest Grove, our 'Millerandage' Pinot Noir is exclusively made with the elusive clone 943. It is said that this was the preferred clone of Professor Raymond Bernard. The clone has only been available to growers in the USA since 2004. This is most certainly not your typical Pinot Noir! This clone suffers from natural millerandage (aka hens & chicks). These tinvberried clusters offer extremely dark colors and a flavor profile that is more boysenberry, iron, and pomegranate. Our grapes are grown in deep loess soils and dry farmed. The wine was destemmed and fermented using only native yeast, and was bottled unfined (vegan) and unfiltered.
